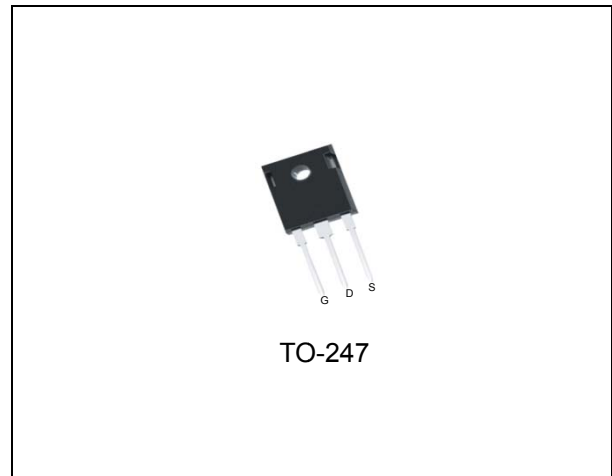

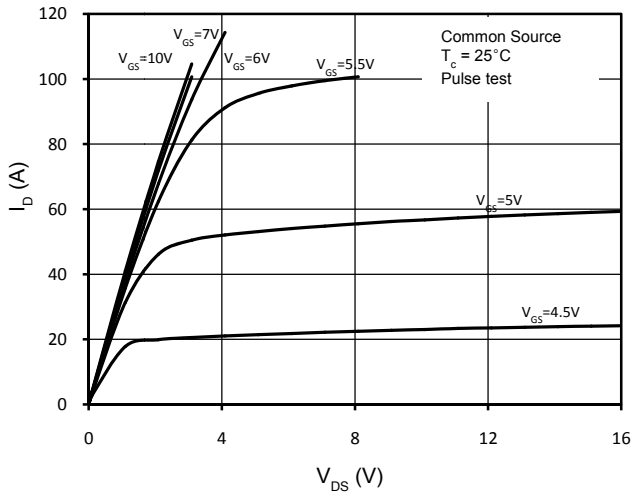


Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics

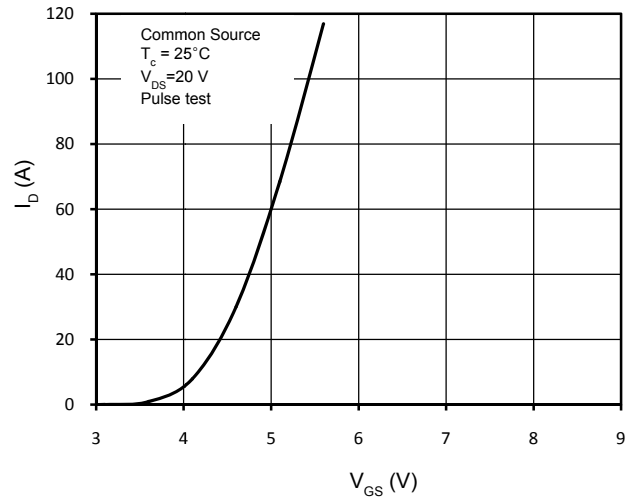


Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics

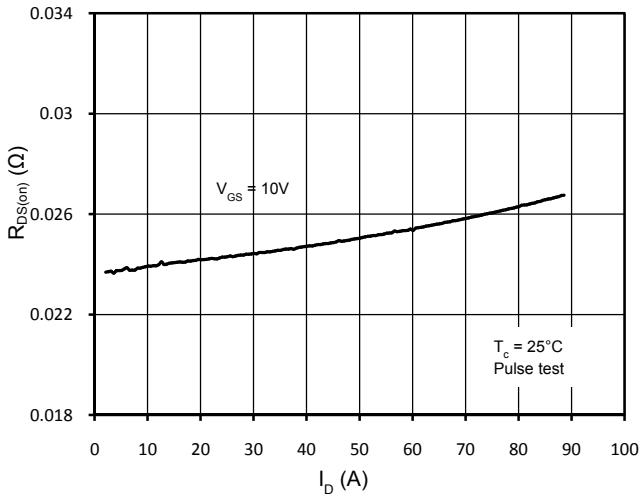


Figure 3. Static Drain-Source On Resistance

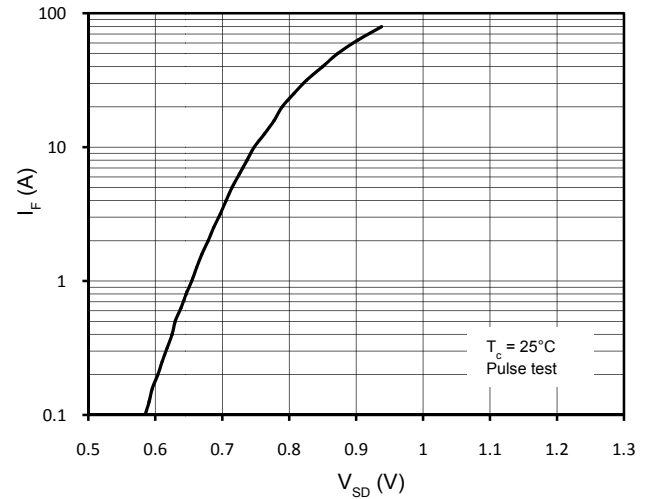


Figure 4. Body-Diode Forward Characteristics



Figure 5. Normalized $BV_{DS(s)}$ vs. Temperature

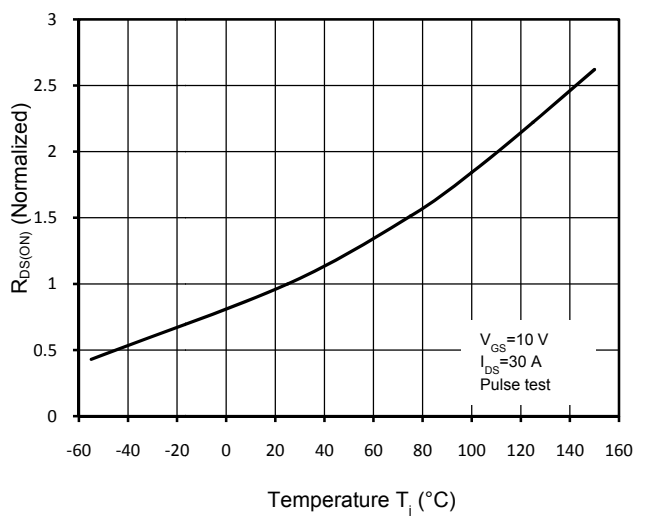


Figure 6. Normalized $R_{DS(on)}$ vs. Temperature

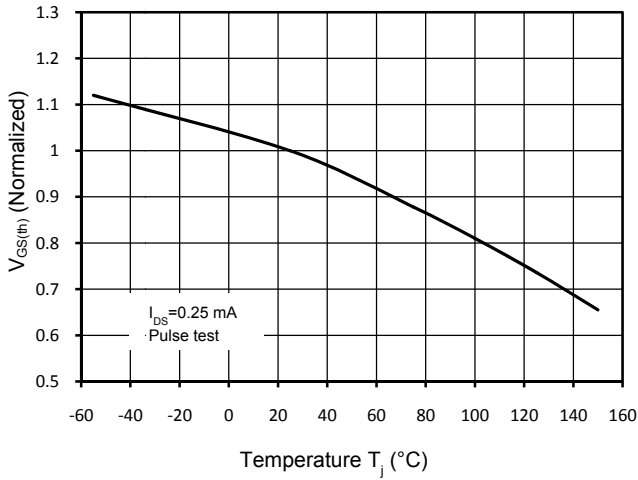


Figure 7. Threshold Voltage vs. Temperature

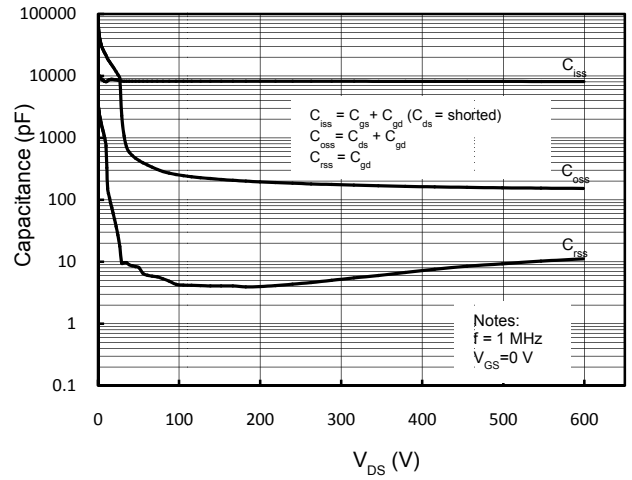


Figure 8. Capacitance Characteristics

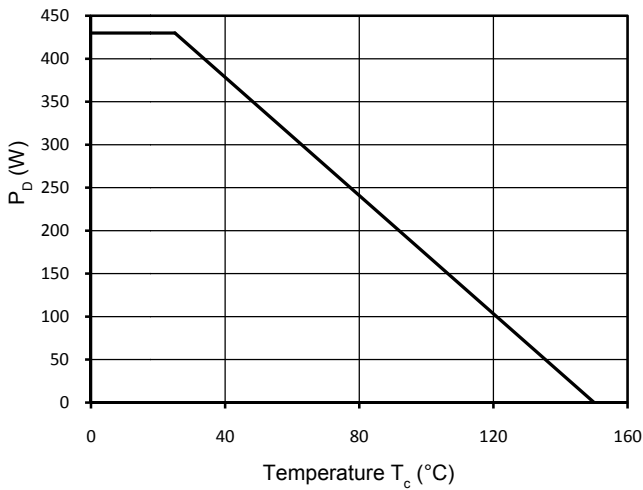


Figure 9. Power Dissipation

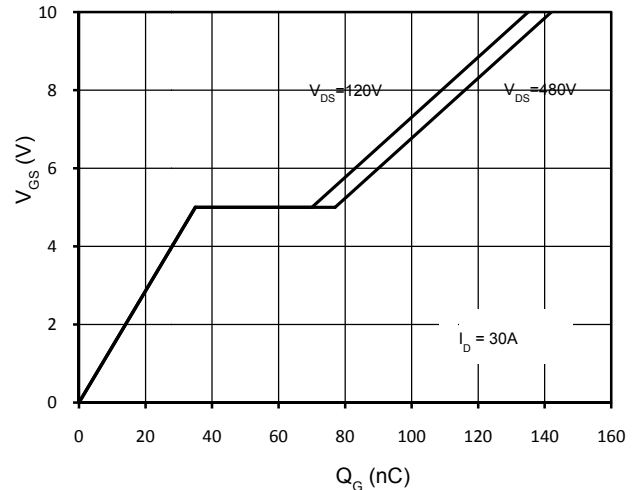


Figure 10. Gate Charge Characteristics

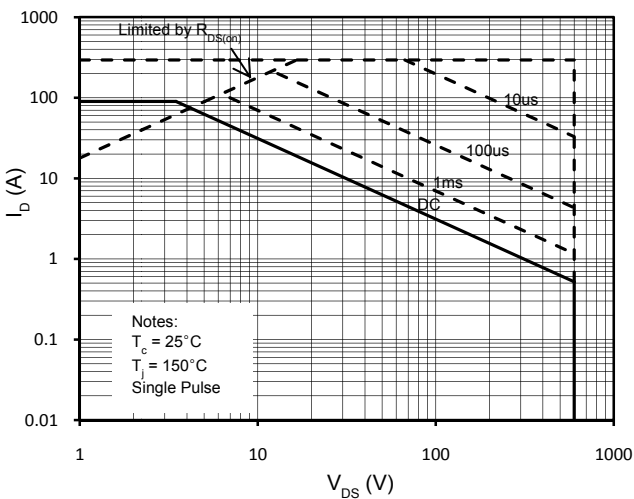


Figure 11. Maximum Safe Operating Area

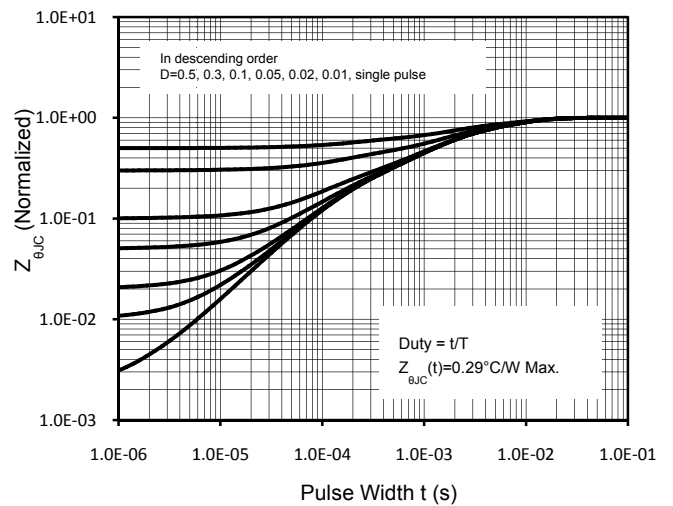
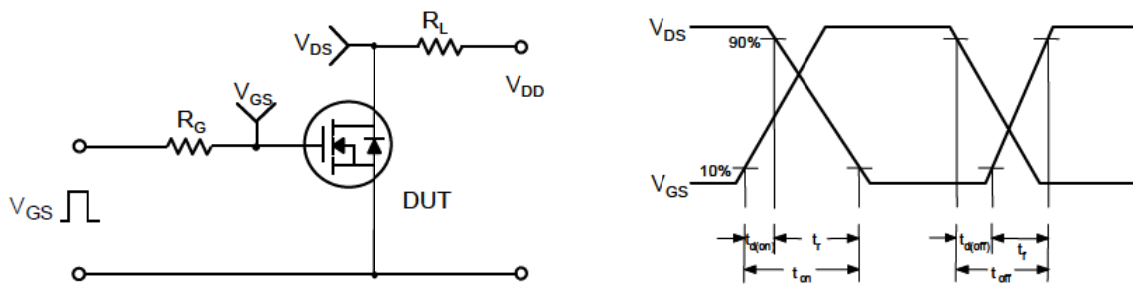


Figure 12. Transient Thermal Response Curve

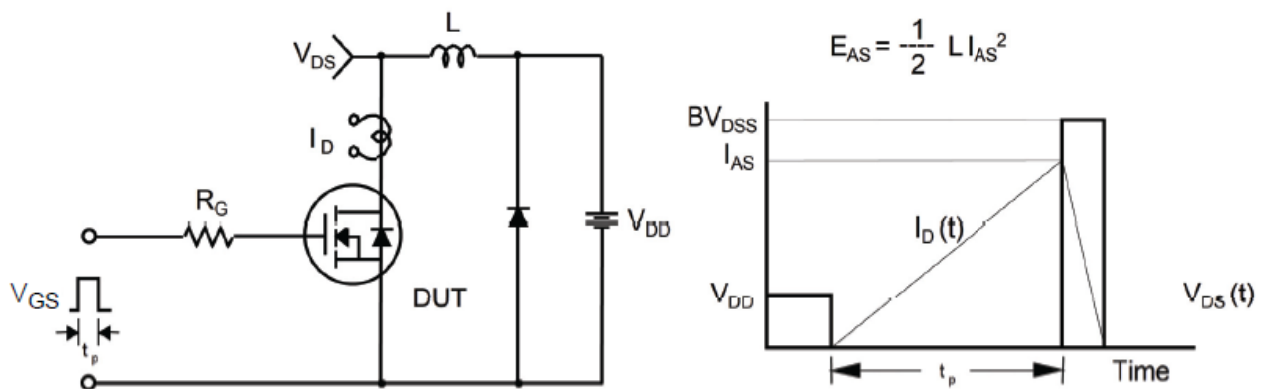
Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform



Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms

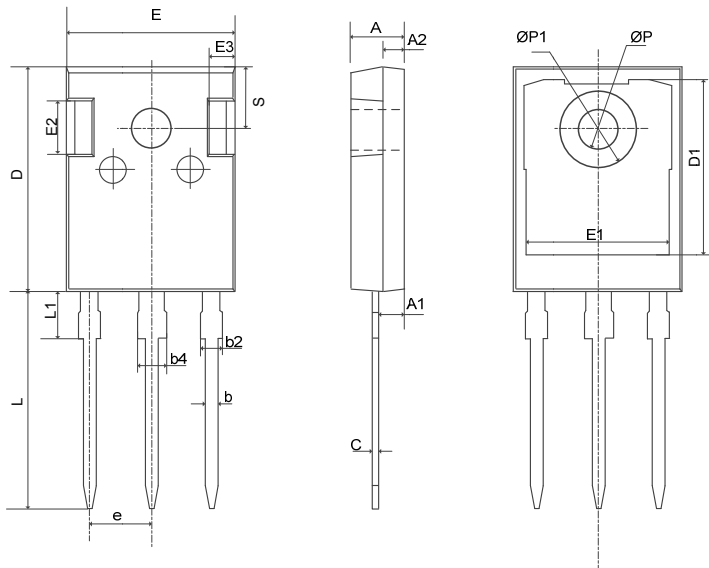


Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms

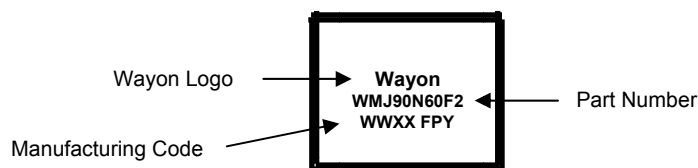
